Depicting Fidelity and Immortality, the Ivy also symbolizes Everlasting Life and Eternal Affection.


The Tulip is a floral emblem of Charity and the Declaration of Love.





Respect for the Word of God is represented by the Holy Bible. It marks Divine Authority, Perfect Knowledge, and is the Book of Wisdom.




Signifying the Birth of Hope, the Poinsettia indicates the Nativity and the Birth of Christ.
